The Aamodt Settlement and Its Impact on our Association

Dear Member:

As the Aamodt Settlement proceeds toward final approval and implementation, the Board and its members will ultimately have an important decision to make: **To continue as an independent Association or to join the Regional Water System that is planned to be available in the future.** This will be a decision that will depend on many factors that need to be identified and described.

To begin this process, the Board will be working on necessary changes to the By-Laws of the Association for Membership review, discussion, and approval to ensure we have the ability and appropriate processes in place to make this important decision, without regard to the ultimate outcome.

In addition, the Board will work to identify and communicate to the Membership the many factors that are important to be considered in the making of this decision.

The specific date by which this decision needs to be made is not known at this time, but it is most likely in the 1 to 2 year timeframe, which gives us time to gather the appropriate questions and answers and to develop the ultimate Association position on whether we stay independent or join the Regional Water System.

We plan to communicate information important to the making of this decision, as it is available, so that each member will be kept fully informed.
